# 28th UNDERWOOD CUP - RECAP & MATCH RESULTS

-Amateurs defeat Professionals 17 ½ to 6 ½ -

JACKSONVILLE, FL - After a close first set of morning Four-Ball matches on Monday, the Amateurs overpowered the Professionals in the afternoon Foursomes and followed suite in Tuesday's Singles play to claim the  $28^{th}$  Underwood Cup by a score of 17 % to 6 % at Timuquana Country Club. It was the Amateurs eighth Cup win in the last nine matches. Their 17 %-point total was the highest in Cup history.

The Amateurs held a slim 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  lead following the opening Four-Ball play before grabbing all six available points in the afternoon Foursomes to take a commanding 9  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  lead. In Tuesday's 12 singles matches, the Amateurs got off to another strong start and the Cup was theirs again when Jeff Golden closed out Gus Barchers. Captain John Milton's team would earn eight Singles points, resulting in the new Underwood Cup record for total team points.

The Amateurs now lead the series, which pits the best golfers of the Northern Chapter of the North Florida PGA vs. North Florida's top amateurs, 14-11-3.

The matches are conducted by the Northern Chapter of the North Florida PGA and are supported by the Jacksonville Area Golf Association (JAGA). Timuquana Country Club has hosted the Underwood Cup all 28 years.

The matches have been sponsored since their inception in 1992 by Underwood Jewelers, with Clayton Bromberg of Underwood serving as the Honorary Starter and host of the post-event luncheon and awards ceremony.
